

“Go Bucket” Supply List

Item	Quantity	Description/Use
5 Gallon Bucket/Lid	675	NEED MET
Water	675	Case of bottled water
Flashlight	675	To provide light and calm nerves and alleviate stress if in the dark.
Glass breaker	675	If needed for exiting windows. (Flashlight/glass breaker combo)
First Aid Kit	675	To address minor injuries that may arise.
Stop the bleed kit	675	Contains the necessary items to control serious bleeding and prevent further blood loss for a victim suffering a traumatic injury. (Includes tourniquet ,prices range from \$50 - \$150 per kit)
Kitty litter	675	Can be used in conjunction with the bucket
Latex Gloves	675	Use as barrier between self and injured people. Do not touch body fluids of others without gloves.
Duct Tape	675	Tape signs to windows. Hold shower curtain. Wrap tightly above a wound to act as a tourniquet
Shower curtain	675	Used for privacy if bucket needs to be used for a restroom
Dumb/Dumb suckers	675 bags	For diabetics and/or to occupy and distract children.
Granola bars	1350 boxes	Nonperishable to provide nourishment
Fruit snacks	675 boxes	Nonperishable to provide nourishment
Ace Wrap/Compression bandage	675	Used for basic first aid. Wrap over bandage and pull tightly. Possible tourniquet if pulled out tight.
Additional gauze	675	In addition to first aid kit. Cover small wounds/bleeding control.
Small garbage bag/gallon zip lock	675	Collection of waste, bodily waste if no other option.
Whistle	675	For use after a tornado to help with location
Black garbage bags (Lg 55 gallon)	675	Use for backup collection on body fluid-soaked items. Cut open and use as a cover sheet if needed
Tourniquet	675	To stop bleeding. Place above injury location and tighten at closest artery.
